Q1 –

Ratio of fiction : non-fiction : poetry is 7 : 5 : 4.

There are 256 books altogether.

$$7 + 5 + 4 = 16$$

$$256 \div 16 = 16$$

Fiction: $7 \times 16 = 112$ **Non-fiction:** $5 \times 16 = 80$ **Poetry:** $4 \times 16 = 64$
